To meet out the requirements of the increased strength, there has been an enhancement in the infrastructure facilities. A new "**AACHARYA PADUKA BLOCK**" was constructed and inaugurated on 02<sup>nd</sup> June, 2025 by Sri S. Krishnan, IAS, Secretary, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India in the presence of Dr. K.S. Devanathan, Urologist, Trustee, Sri K. Prabhakaran, Advocate and Legal Adviser of our school and Dr. R. Krishnan, Cardiologist, Trichy.

The school is equipped with full-fledged Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer and Robotics Labs with the latest equipment's to meet out the updated syllabi and needs and a Home Theatre to teach Value Education. I would like to add that all our classrooms are AV aided with the latest contents, software and hardware.

We have a well-stocked library with **9765** books, which is regularly used by students and teachers.

To fulfil the requirement of sports personalities of the school, a playground of 1.5 acres is added to the infrastructure opposite to the school premises.

## **ACADEMICS**

Our Class X and XII results were 100% as usual. Kum. **Keerthana R** scored 494 out of 500 marks in Class **X**. Master **Srivathsan S** scored 480 out of 500 marks in Class **XII** in Commerce stream and Kum. **Harsheetha RG** scored 477 out of 500 marks in Science stream. I feel proud to share that many of our students cleared **NEET** and **JEE** and have joined Medicine and Engineering in various prestigious Institutions.
